

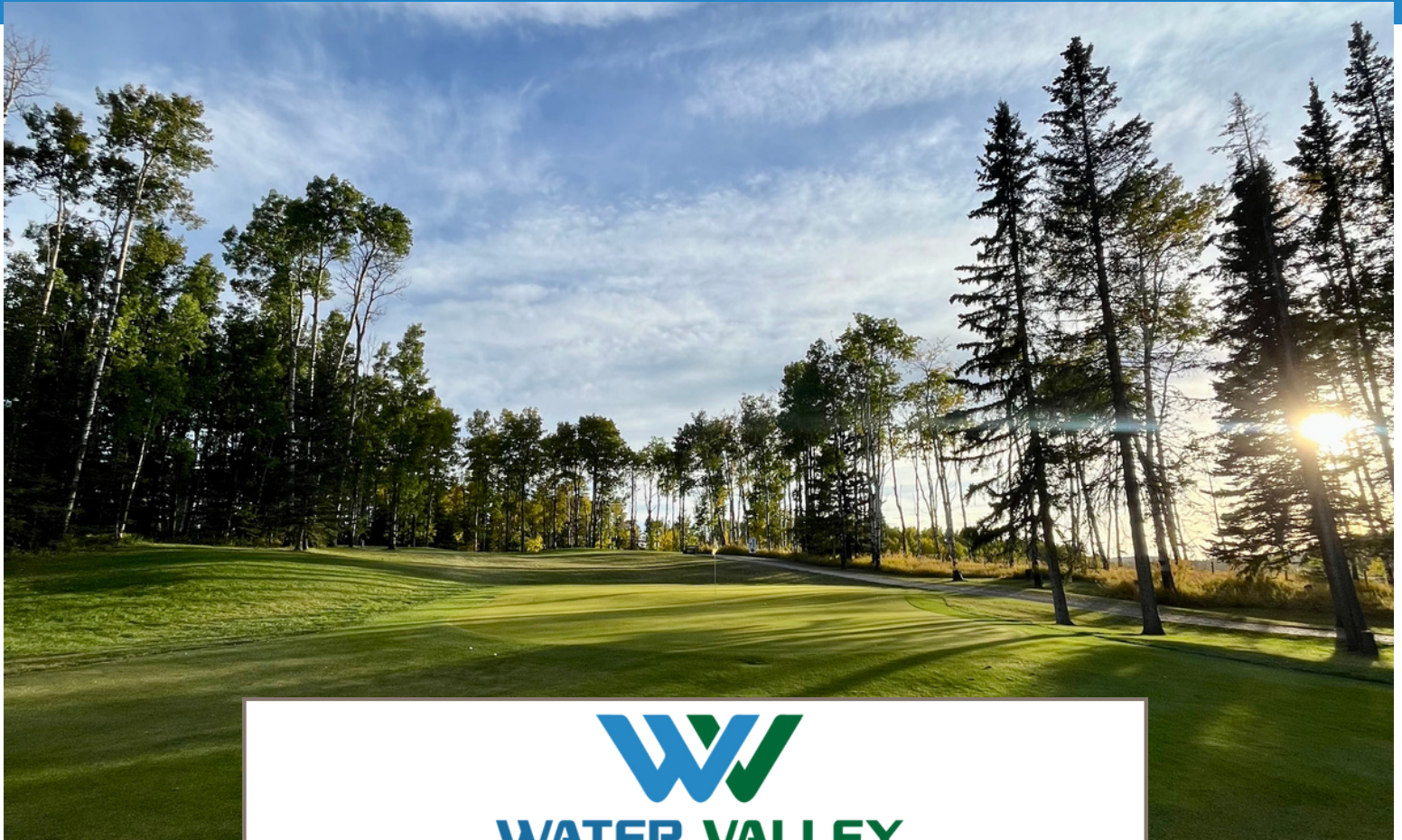

## WEEKLY LEAGUES

**Senior Men's-** Mondays, 9am tee times, from May 15th to September 11th, 18 holes

**Super Seniors-** Wednesdays, 9am tee times, from May 17th to September 13th, back 9

## SENIOR MEN'S INTER-CLUB

### SIGN UP DEADLINE 04.28.2023



Senior Men's Inter-Club is an opportunity for our Senior Men's Season Pass Holders to join in playing many area golf clubs within a competitive format. If you have any questions please feel free to contact our league representative Robin Boyd at [rola@telus.net](mailto:rola@telus.net).

Here is a brief outline of the format:

Each week starting in May, four players from our Senior Men's League, 2 low handicap and 2 high handicap players (these being the "A" team and "B" team), play a match play game at our home course. The following week a return match is played at the course of that opposing team or vice versa.

Scoring is a "best ball" three point Nassau (1 point each for the front nine, back nine, and aggregate) with the "A" players playing against each other and the "B" players playing each other.

The home team's members are the hosts of the opposing team and as such are responsible for picking up the tab for the visiting players drinks, meals and snacks. The fees are \$180 (divided among the involved team members) and the cost of joining our Senior Men's League. For Senior Mens Inter-Club participants you can purchase new WV Logo shirts for \$35 each, and 2022 Grey WV Sweaters for \$35 each (limited # available).

Participants must:

- be 55+ years of age.
- be an active member in the Water Valley Senior Men's Club.
- have a valid 2023 Golf Canada membership & handicap factor.
- be able to complete 18 holes in 4 hours or less.
